Establishing the Saint Paul City Council Early Learning Legislative Advisory Committee

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council adopted Resolution 22-1183 on July 27, 2022 committing to strengthening families, education, and the workforce through the exploration of early care and education accessibility; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 22-1183 outlined the need for early care and education for Saint Paul's youngest children; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 22-1183 committed to the establishment of an Early Learning Legislative Advisory Committee by September 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 22-1183 empowered the Committee to make recommendations to the City Council on the potential design and implementation of a locally governed early learning program, to explore funding options, and, if appropriate, to propose legislation that would effectuate and codify the Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council seeks to establish a Committee reflective of Saint Paul with diverse membership representing multiple perspectives; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Saint Paul City Council will provide professional and clerical staff support to the work of the Early Learning Legislative Advisory Committee; and be it further
