This building was located with in a complex with limited access points, that limited placement of rigs. Due to staffing levels E24 and L 24 arrived to a 2 story multi family complex with heavy smoke and fire coming from the second story deck and roof. E24 deployed a 2 1/2 inch attach line for fire attack. L24 assisted with entry and exposure control. E24 secured a water supply to themselves and L24.</p> <p>S1 preformed a primary search of the fire unit and L7 got a all clear on the rest of the building. E4 and E9 pulled secondary lines for fire attack of exposure apartments and exterior protection. L8 was IRIT and Car 50 was FIT. Board up and Red Cross were called to assist with resident placement and securing of the structure. S3 performed the investigation on this incident and is working on a cause.</p> <p>Investigation unit Summary Just a heads up, the upstairs condo resident admitted to having a cigarette on his deck before he left for work. He put it in a coffee can on his deck.</p> <p>The fire department was called to the report of a fire in a second floor condo. Firefighters arrived and found an exterior second floor deck fire that extended into the roof. Firefighters evacuated the structure, extinguished the fire and conducted overhaul. Property conservation efforts were made to the lower condo unit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Squad 3 was assigned as the investigations unit. -Fire damaged condo residents where located and notified. -Housing for affected condo residents initiated. -Condo management company notified.
