Dear Mr. Gutierrez & Ms. Gutierrez:

This is to confirm that on September 14, 2021 at the Legislative Hearing, Ms. Moermond will recommend that the City Council grant 180 days to rehabilitate the above-named property on the condition the following conditions are met by close of business Monday, September 20, 2021:

- 1) Submit updated/additional financing to reflect an additional \$5,000;
- 2) Submit an updated Vanguard statement reflecting the funds were successfully transferred to the account;
- 3) submit an updated affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- 4) the property must continue to be maintained

The City Council Public Hearing is scheduled for September 22, 2021 at 3:30 p.m. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, **we will not be holding hearings in person.** If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation, you may send written testimony to be added to the record to legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us or by voicemail at 651-266-6805.
