



RESOLUTION # 22-12

Recommend approval of the First Amendment to Management Agreement between the City of Saint Paul and Be Graceful Bakery and Catering, LLC ("Be Graceful") to operate food and beverage concessions at several Parks and Recreation facilities.

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission ("Commission") is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and city-wide matters related to Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the City and Be Graceful entered into an Agreement on September 4, 2020 for the management of food and beverage concessions at multiple parks facilities which terminates on September 6, 2023; and

WHEREAS, that agreement requires Be Graceful to make commission payments to the City based on monthly gross revenue generated; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to have concessions available for the public during the winter sports season at Battle Creek Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, Be Graceful has successfully met all contractual terms and has the ability to provide concessions out of the Battle Creek Recreation Center during the winter sports season; and

WHEREAS, Saint Paul Administrative Code requires that any lease of parkland or recreation facilities which will be for a period of more than one year be approved by the City Council following a hearing before the Parks and Recreation Commission; now

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission recommends the approval of First Amendment to the Management Agreement between the City of Saint Paul and Be Graceful to operate food and beverage concessions at several Parks and Recreation facilities.
