The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 10, 2021 with a pre-event sound check from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 10, 2021 for Fall 2021 Commencement for 2020 Graduation, at 2115 Summit Avenue - O'Shaughnessy Stadium. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources on October 10, 2021. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 4:00 p.m. on October 10, 2021.

Applicant has acknowledged that any social gathering associated with this variance must be managed in full compliance with all applicable Governor Walz and Mayor Carter COVID-19 Orders including but not limited to Orders relating to distancing, mask wearing and attendance limits.
