Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 830 IGLEHART AVE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 17, 2011, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on March 17, 2011 at 2:00 pm or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- 2. Basement SPC 4715.1300 Provide a removable strainer and a clean out plug or cap for the floor drain.
- 3. Basement SPLC 34.10 (1) Abate and maintain the basement reasonably free from dampness and free of mold and mildew.
- 4. Both Units SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-All openable windows require a screen, replace where missing.
- 5. Exterior House SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from

- chipped or peeling paint.-Repair damaged area of soffit and fascia in rear. Scrape and paint as necessary where peeling or where bare wood is exposed.
- 6. Exterior Rear SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
- 7. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
- 8. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.
- 9. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame.-Repair and seal deteriorated wood and putty as necessary.
- 10. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
- 11. Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.
- 12. Garage SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.33 Repair and maintain the damaged structural member. This repair may require a building permit, call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 13. Garage SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
- 14. Garage SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-This garage is condemned due to partial collapse of building.
- 15. Lower Unit MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-Replace low battery backup in detector.
- 16. Rear Entry SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls and ceiling in an approved manner.-Scrape and paint where peeling.
- 17. Throughout MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 18. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 19. SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-Provide access for re-inspection on March 17, 2011 at 2:00 pm to verify completion of all deficiencies or vacate of the building.
