Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at <u>1722 Reaney Avenue</u>

Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on April 26, 2022 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond laid the matter over to Legislative Hearing on Tuesday, May 10, 2022 via phone between 9 and 11:00 am.

By close of business May 6, 2022, if doing the rehabilitation themselves, the owner must:

- 1. Submit an updated bid including **electrical** work that addresses all items in the Code Compliance Inspection report;
- 2. An affidavit from the financial institution dedicating funds to the project;
- 3. A schedule/work plan for completing the project; and
- 4. The property must be maintained.

If selling the property they must also submit a purchase agreement stating title won't transfer until the rehabilitation is complete.

If a third party purchaser will be doing the rehabilitation, then <u>in addition to the above items</u>, <u>the purchaser must:</u>

- 1. Submit proof of financing dedicated to completing the rehabilitation;
- 2. Post a new \$5,000 Performance Deposit with the Department of Safety & Inspections;
- **3.** Their own work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work. This should include signed subcontractor bids and a <u>schedule</u> for completion of the project (if not using NorthSight)

These items can be emailed to me at <u>Joanna.zimny@ci.stpaul.mn.us</u> or dropped off in our office at 310 W Kellogg Ave, Room 310 Monday through Friday between 8 am and 4 pm. Samples were sent previously. The Performance Deposit form can be found online here: <u>https://www.stpaul.gov/departments/safety-inspections/vacant-buildings</u>.

This matter will go before the City Council again on Wednesday, May 25 2022 at 3:30 p.m. in room 300 City Hall. If you are contesting the recommendation Ms. Moermond will give at the May 10 hearing, you may appear in person or send written testimony to be added to the record to <u>legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us</u> or by voicemail at 651-266-6805. Should you wish to address Council directly but not appear in person, you must register in person by noon on the Tuesday immediately prior to your Public Hearing here:

https://www.stpaul.gov/department/city-council/city-council-public-hearing-live-testimony. If you don't wish to contest, no further action is needed and the Council will go with Ms. Moermond's recommendation above.
