

# Transportation, utility and other transmission service facilities and corridors shall avoid:

- g. Soils susceptible to erosion
- h. Areas of unstable soils
- i. Areas with high water tables

Leg. Code § 68.402(b)(5)



# In RC3 River Corridor Urban Open Overlay District:

Maximum building height is 40 feet

"Buildings shall be set back a minimum of fifty (50) feet from every property line, plus an additional two (2) feet for every foot the building's height exceeds fifty (50) feet."

Leg. Code § 65.220(b)

"No building or grading permit shall be issued for any project subject to this section until a TDMP has been prepared."

Leg. Code § 63.122(c)

"No use shall be permitted which is likely to cause pollution of water, as defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 115.01, unless adequate safeguards, approved by the state pollution control agency, are provided."

Leg. Code § 68.233(d)

Section 61.503 of the Legislative Code requires a new conditional use permit when a change (as defined below) occurs:

A change to a conditional use requires a new permit when one (1) of the following conditions occurs:

• • • •

(b) The floor area of a conditional use expands by fifty (50) percent or more. For a conditional use existing on October 25, 1975, expansion is the sum of the floor area of all the expansions since then.

For a conditional use established after October 25, 1975, expansion is the sum of the floor area of all the expansions since being established. Floor area does not include floor area which is accessory to a principal use and which does not result in the expansion of a principal use.
