





Today is a part of more than 17 years in the making of this downtown place, a PARK that the community is passionate about





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
Interim park expectations after demolition of PSA :

- * flat open space with trees
- * site lighting
- * benches/picnic tables
- * water source for gardening
- * porta-potty pad
- * sidewalk

Estimated cost to implement interim plan :

\$800,000

(Note: this does not include retaining wall along alley and surface parking lot)






