Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at 2117 Mohawk Avenue

Dear Corrine & Lee Coulter:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on June 11, 2024 the Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond continued the matter to Legislative Hearing on **Tuesday, July 9, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.** in room 330 City Hall/Courthouse (or via phone between 9 and 11 am) **for further discussion.**

For your reference, the following must eventually be completed in order to receive a grant of time to rehabilitate the property:

- 1. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation.** Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis;
- 2. \$5,000 Performance Deposit** posted with the Department of Safety & Inspections;
- 3. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project** and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued;
- 4. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids which address all items in the Code Compliance Inspection Report and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and
- 5. the property must continue to be maintained.**

Note that if you are intending to have a third party rehabilitate the property, pending transfer of title, the contract used for this transaction will need to be approved by the Legislative Hearing Officer. **Please note that title cannot transfer until the rehabilitation is complete and nuisance abated.** I have included samples of these document.
