2023-2024 Saint Paul Citywide Enterprise Approach to Snow Operations/Snow Emergencies

City established five cross-departmental working groups:

Snow Operations

- o Inventoried current equipment
- Trained several on-call city staff to plow using pick up trucks, including Mayor Carter
- Reviewed bike path and trail maintenance with Parks and PW
- Reviewed other cities and municipalities snow operations models
 - Talked and visited with other city winter ops staff
 - Held a table top exercise for a 1-sided snow operations model
- Continued conversations and partnerships with SPPS, Ramsey County, MnDOT, Metro Transit

HR – Hiring/Recruitment/Retention

- Hired approximately 100 ticketers from external candidates and internal city staff
- Increased street maintenance staffing, promotions and filling vacancies, including adding 4 new FTEs

Ticketing and Towing

- Negotiated new towing contract, with a lower towing cost and requires them to have a towing manager for snow emergencies
- Proposing new ordinance language to allow ROW inspectors to ticket year-round for parking violations that directly impact street maintenance operations (sweeping, plowing, ROW permits)

Private Snow Plowing Operations

- Reviewed and proposing new ordinance language updates for sidewalk and private plowing operations
- o DSI worked with private contractor for mitigating sidewalk shoveling complaints
- Created new education flyers/handouts for businesses and residents to educate where they can put snow (NOT in the street)

• Communications and Engagement

- Held successful first-ever community Snow Summit and Alley Captain Conference
- Created new Alley Captain resource page with documents and videos
- Created new partnership with Everbridge Resident Connect as a communications tool, which includes sending a recorded voice mail message (English only) to approximately 168,000 resident and business landlines and mobile phones registered in Saint Paul proper.
- Secured a Block 19 parking ramp for free parking during the Night and Day Plow phases of a Snow Emergency for anyone to use
- Added new signage and language at LRT and BRT stations in Saint Paul with Metro Transit
- Added City Instagram to social media platforms to educate and inform about snow operations and snow emergencies
