RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2024 MAXIMUM HRA

PROPERTY TAX LEVY

Requested Board Action

Certify the maximum 2024 HRA Tax Levy.

Background

The HRA property tax levy provides revenue to the HRA to invest in affordable housing

development, housing stability, and in business and job growth in Saint Paul.

State law caps the HRA levy at 0.0185% of the estimated market value of taxable property. The

market value of taxable property in Saint Paul is projected to be \$34 billion in 2024, up from \$30.6

billion in 2023. The proposed maximum 2024 HRA tax levy is \$6,294,694 which is 100% of the

maximum allowed under State Law. The proposed maximum HRA tax levy for 2024 is \$637,544

more than the amount levied for the HRA in 2023.

To comply with the State of Minnesota's Truth-In-Taxation laws, by September 30, 2023, the

HRA must certify to Ramsey County a maximum proposed property tax levy payable in 2024.

The attached resolution, if approved, will certify a proposed maximum levy by that date. The final

levy must be certified on or before five working days after December 20, 2023 and cannot be

higher than this proposed maximum levy.

Future Action

The Saint Paul City Council approval is also needed and is scheduled for the September 27, 2023

City Council meeting. The dates reserved for adopting the final 2024 HRA tax levy and budget

are December 6, 2023 and December 13, 2023.

Recommendation:

Approval of the proposed maximum HRA Tax Levy payable in 2024 to certify to Ramsey County by September 30, 2023.
