NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 6, 2023.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on or after March 8, 2023.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

1. 1035 Bradley St - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 111.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used

until re-inspected and approved by this office.-Condemnation due to but not limited water meter being removed and water being turned of by SPRWS and gas shut off by Xcel.

- 2. 1035 Bradley St MFGC 406.5.2 Immediately repair or replace the leaking fuel equipment piping. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-No gas. Turned off by Xcel.
- 3. 1035 Bradley St SPLC 34.11 (4), 34.35 (1), MPC 601.1 Provide an adequate water supply to all water closets, sinks, showers and tubs.-Water meter removed, water turned off by SPRWS.
- 4. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke alarm affidavit and return it to this office.
