Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on August 18, 2021. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Back of House SPLC 34.08 (2) Provide and maintain the property grade to slope away from the building to minimize the accumulation of water near the building. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-NEW June 3, 2021 The bottom downspout piece that slopes water away from the property is still broken.
- 2. Exterior Back of Property SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-The shed at the back of the property is still in disrepair with cracked boards and a hole in the fascia on the other side of the shed. There is a section of the back fence that is damaged and the wood is rotten.
- 3. Exterior Back of Property SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.32 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.-There is garbage, tires, furniture and other items improperly disposed of in the back yard.

- 4. Exterior Guardrail SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the damaged guardrail in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-The left guardrail (facing upward) at the back of the house is still loose and unsecured.
- 5. Exterior Window Screen SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen. There is a window screen at the back of the house that is damaged.
- 6. SPLC 40.06. Suspension, revocation and denial. (a) Grounds for revocation. The fire code official may, in writing, issue a notice to the owner(s) and known interested parties of the city's suspension or revocation of a fire certificate of occupancy issued under the provisions of this code, or deny an application therefor: (3)If it is found upon inspection of the fire code official that the building or occupancy is in violation of provisions of this or other applicable safety codes, ordinances, rules and regulations;

 The Fire Certificate of Occupancy has been revoked due to failure to comply with the City Council's resolution.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
