## Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 421 UNIVERSITY AVE W

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on August 29, 2017, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

## A re-inspection will be made on October 6, 2017 at 3:00 PM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Exterior Check All SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-
  - 8/7/17: Screens are still damaged or missing from windows.
- 2. Interior 423B MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-8/7/17: 423B-Hardwired smoke detector missing at inspection.

  8/29/17: still not in place.
- 3. Interior Basement and Food Service Area MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-6/12/17: Still missing. Check All.

- Interior Check All SPLC 34.10 (7) Repair and maintain the cabinets in an approved manner.-6/12/17:
   Cabinets still in poor condition, doors and drawer fronts missing.
   Kitchen cabinet doors to be in place and closeable.
- 5. Interior Check All MSFC 703.1 Provide, repair or replace the fire rated door and assembly.-Repair and maintain the door closer(s). Repair and maintain the door latches. Front entry door to close and latch.
  Unit 421A entry door.
  8/7/17: Unit 423B has new door, deadbolt/closer has not been installed in door.
- 6. Interior Floor at Exhaust Hood/Duct Penetration in Hallway SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17(5) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-
- 7. Interior For Mixed Use Area SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-To prevent rodent intrusion.
- 8. Interior Hallway MSFC 703.1 Repair and maintain the required fire resistive construction with approved materials and methods. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-6/12/17: Main floor kitchen area to second floor dwelling units.
- 9. Interior See Comments SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-6/12/17: existing conditions.

  Unit B: Tub faucet handles broken.
- 10. Interior See Comments SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-Unit A: Bathtub overflow missing.

  Unit 423B: secure toilet, rocking; bathtub faucet broken.
- 11. Interior Throughout-all units and food service SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.34 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.- 8/23/17: German cockroaches observed in unit 423A.
- 12. Interior Units 421A & B, Unit 423A & B MSFC 1030.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work requires a licensed contractor to obtain a permit(s) and contact city inspection staff for review of the work and approval of the installation. Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-8/29/17:

  Cannot verify sleeping rooms were enclosed under permit, no egress windows in sleeping rooms. Remove the door and 50% of walls, at a minimum or door and wall in entirety. No permit is required for this as the walls in question are not load-bearing walls.
- 13. Interior Basement MSFC 315.3 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.-

- 14. Interior Exhaust Hood Penetration in Hallway MSFC 703.1, 1106.1 Provide and maintain fire rated floor and/or ceiling construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. The minimum rating must be: 1 hour.-
- 15. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
