Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm at the Legislative Hearing on August 22, 2023 this matter was continued to Legislative Hearing on September 12, 2023 at 9 am in room 330 City Hall/Court House to discuss any potential plans for rehab with a purchaser.

This matter will again go before the City Council at Public Hearing on Wednesday, September 20, 2023 at 3:30 pm. in room 300 City Hall. If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation from the September 12 hearing you may:

- 1. appear in person (please arrive before 3:30 p.m. and check in with staff outside Council chambers); or
- 2. Should you wish to address Council directly but not appear in person, you must register in person by noon on Tuesday, September 19, 2023 here to testify via phone: https://www.stpaul.gov/department/city-council/city-council-public-hearing-live-testimony.

<u>For your reference, the following items must (eventually) be completed before receiving a</u> grant of time from the City Council to rehabilitate the property:



- 1. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates costs to exceed \$100,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis;
- 2. post a \$5,000 Performance Deposit with the Department of Safety & Inspections. This will be a requirement before the August 2, 2023 Public Hearing for any future layovers;
- 3. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- **4. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and
- 5. the property must be maintained.
