Dear Council Members,

Good afternoon,

I am attending the hearing on January 17, 2024.

Thank you, council members, for giving me an opportunity to speak with you at this hearing.

My name is Inho Chang, who am the owner of the property.

I am not a native English speaker, so my English is not perfect. Please bear with me for my not perfect English.

The property had a fire incident on 4/6/2022. When I started working on having it repaired, everyone was short-handed and was extremely slow to respond to my requests, such as getting the police report, the insurance claim, finding contractors. Especially, I had a hard time to find right contractors. While the general building contractor I hired was working on repairing fire damages, I was able to have an electric contractor and got his proposal much later Feb. 2023 (see the attachment) after multiple interviews with contractors. The repair work has been taking a longer time than I anticipated.

The repair has been almost done June 2023. However, someone broke into the property and damaged the basement and stole the pipes for water heater, boiler, the water meter, and cut out electric wire on last June 2023 (see the attached police report). This caused me to take on an additional long period of time taking care of another round of plumbing, heating and electrical work and dealing with insurance. These works are in progress. I hope this information helps you understand why the repair took longer than expected.

I have a concern about the city's handling of this matter.

First, attached are the letters I received from the city for the vacant building registration notice, April, and May 2022 (see attachment). My record shows that I have not received any letter regarding Vacant Building registration fee notice since then. I would like to let you know that I diligently keep all the letters, notices, bills, etc. that I receive from the city, the County and other entities, and corresponds in my file with my best effort. Even with my best effort I might have overlooked or misplaced them.

As a result, I did not have any knowledge of how long I have the vacant building registration fee extended.

Second, how long do I expected to have a house with significant fire damage repair done? In 3, 6, 12, 24 months? I had fire with entire house from second floor and attic and the first floor.

Can you grant me Vacant Building registration fee less than the full 2 years?

As the owner of the property, I do want to get the repair done as soon as possible because while it is under repair, I am not getting any income. I am underwater.

VACANT BUILDING REGISTRATION NOTICE

If the registration fee is not received in this office within 45 days of the date of this letter, the full amount owed will be assessed to, and collected with, the taxes for this property as permitted by Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 43.

The Code Enforcement Officer has notified the Building Inspection and Design Section that this property meets the legal definition of a registered vacant building and in accordance with Legislative Code Chapter 33, no permits (except demolition, wrecking and removal permits) will be issued until the requirements of all applicable ordinances are fulfilled.

**VACANT BUILDING REGISTRATION FEE
WARNING LETTER**

The Saint Paul City Council has adopted legislation which requires owners of vacant buildings to pay an annual fee and submit a registration plan on the form(s) enclosed with this letter. The annual fee is **\$2,459.00**. The purpose of this fee is to partially reimburse the City for administrative costs for registering and processing the Vacant Building Owner Registration forms and for the cost of monitoring these properties for compliance with Saint Paul Legislative Codes.

The fee for the vacant building located at 733 THOMAS AVE is now past due. You have fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter to pay this bill before this fee is sent to assessment, to be collected with your property taxes.

DO NOT MAIL CASH

Saint Paul Legislative Code, Chapter 43, requires this fee be paid no later than thirty (30) days after the building becomes vacant, and if not paid, the owner shall be subject to collections and prosecution as prescribed in the Legislative Code. Also, if at any time the registration fee is unpaid and owing, building permits will be denied for this building.

The full amount owed will be assessed to, and collected with, the taxes for this property as permitted by Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 43.

The owner(s) still will be subject to a criminal Summons and Complaint for failure to pay this vacant building registration fee. This citation will necessitate a court appearance in Ramsey County District Court and the owner(s) will be subject to penalties provided for by law. The enclosed registration form must accompany the fee payment.
