

The proceeds of the Bonds will be loaned to Hourcar (the "Borrower"), a Minnesota nonprofit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and used to (i) finance the acquisition of, and certain improvements to, the automotive and repair facilities, located at 206 Wabasha Street South in the City, to be owned and operated by the Borrower, and (ii) pay costs of issuing the Bonds (the "Project"). The Project is located entirely within the City.

The Bonds, if and when issued, will be special, limited revenue obligations of the Issuer payable solely from the revenues expressly pledged to the payment thereof, and will not constitute a charge, lien, or encumbrance upon any property of the City or of the Issuer.

The Bonds will not be a charge against the City's, the Issuer's, or the State of Minnesota's general credit or taxing powers and will not constitute a general or moral obligation of the City or the Issuer, but will be payable from sums to be paid by the Borrower pursuant to one or more revenue agreements.
