PO reports that they had a house fire and the fire department determined that the home was not fit for habitation. PO said everything was on hold while the fire inspection was done. He believed everything (power, water, garbage etc.) was already on hold. PO assumed that if the city came out to place the notice about the house needing to be vacant that all the appropriate services would have been held as a result. Is there record of a hold? WM doesn't seem to have anything when the PO called. Please let the PO know if there is already a hold or if the PO needs to place a hold now.

PO reports that they have been living at 1297 W county Rd B, Roseville 55113. PO reports that they had trouble with the mail being forwarded to their new address. Unfortunately, they had a lot of mail bounce back to the sender while the issue with the postal service was worked out. This may have been why they did not receive the notices of the bills or late fees. PO reports the issue with mail forwarding is worked out now. PO would like to know if the assessments can be removed due to the circumstances or what their next steps are.
