Historical background


- Bookmobile services have been offered in Saint Paul for more than a 100 years.

Our Role

- Bring the library to neighborhoods across Saint Paul where residents experience a barrier(s) that makes getting to a library location more challenging.
- Generate awareness and introduce the library to Saint Paul residents not currently using the library, particularly newcomers to the city
- Provide library services to the community from books to Wi-Fi to programming.

- Community stops

- School-aged children are a focus
- Mainly Saint Paul Public Schools, one charter school
- Classes browse collection and borrow books



Community stops

- Older adult residences
- Neighborhoods with high concentrations of new Americans
- Communities with children



Improvements


- Wheelchair lift(improved accessibility)

Mobile Library

- O More accessible name for people visiting the vehicle's stops, including new Americans to our city and people whose first language is not English.




Funding
