Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at 1011 Burns Avenue

Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on January 24, 2023 at which we were unable to reach you, Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond will recommend that the property is removed within 15 days with no option to repair if before February 1, 2023 you haven't contacted Clint Zane to begin the Code Compliance Inspection process.

Again, once the property is cleaned out, the doors are unscrewed and able to be opened by normal means and a **lock box installed**, contact Clint Zane at ci.stpaul.mn.us or 651-266-9029 to let him know the lock-box combination. This was supposed to have been done by December 21, 2022.

This action must be completed to even be under consideration for further discussion at a Legislative Hearing.

For your reference, the following items must be completed before receiving a grant of time from the City Council to rehabilitate the property:

- 1. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates costs to exceed \$100,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis;
- 2. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the **project** and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- **3. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and
- 4. the property must be maintained.



This matter will go before the City Council at Public Hearing on Wednesday, February 8, 2023 at 3:30 pm. in room 300 City Hall. If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation from the January 24 hearing (or haven't completed the above task(s)) you may:

- appear in person (please arrive before 3:30 p.m. and check in with staff outside Council chambers)
- send written testimony to be added to the record to <u>legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us</u> or by voicemail at 651-266-6805.
