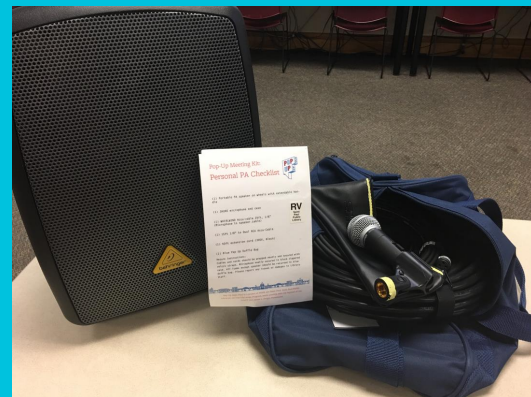
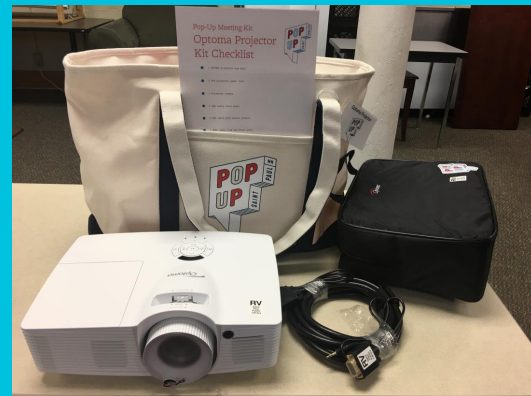
Thank you! This not only helped us reach people who are typically under-represented in our work (kids, English-language learners, renters, people of color), but challenged us to think about our community organizing differently.

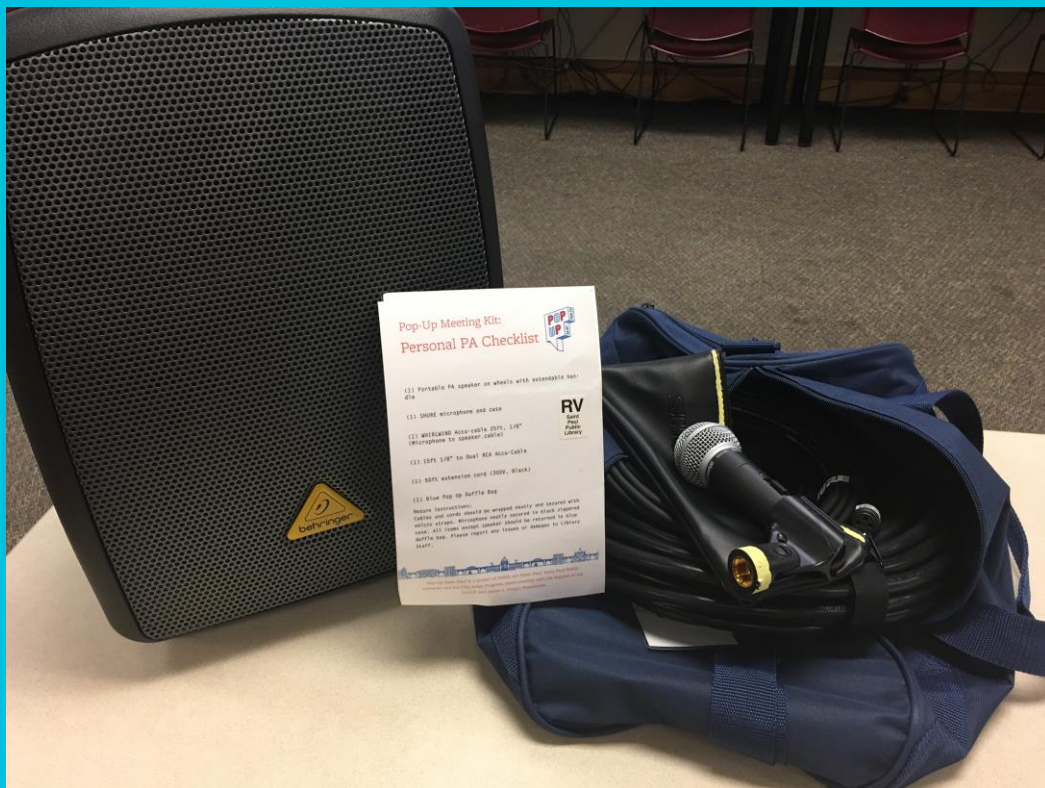

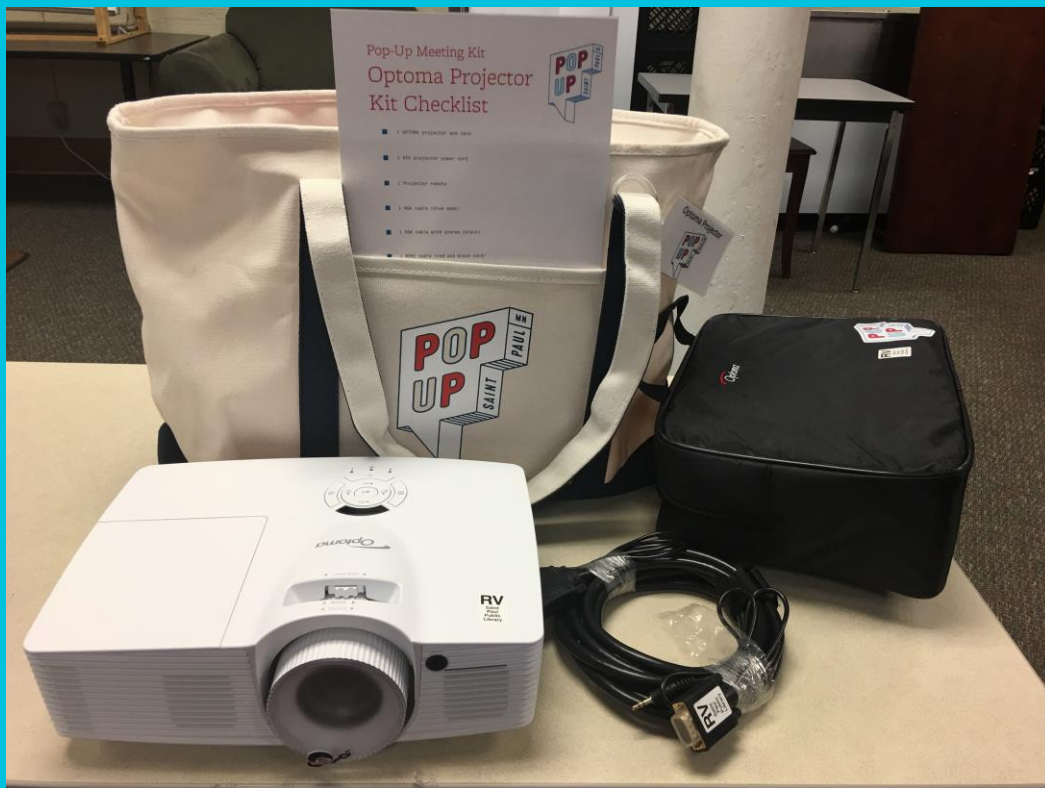
