**Description of Variance:**

**Location:** Plaza in front of the building at 550 Vandalia Street

**Noise Source:** GetKnit Events, represented by Nicholas Blake, has requested a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 95 dBA at 100 feet, to provide the use of a sound system for live, amplified music at 550 Vandalia Street for the Lake Monster Bash event. The variance is requested for the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 28, 2017, with a pre-event sound check at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, October 27, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 28, 2017, with a pre-event sound check at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, October 27, 2017, for the Lake Monster Bash event on Saturday, October 28, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. The applicant may need to provide a barrier, to act as a sound absorber, to contain excess sound from leaving the area 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:30 p.m. on the date of the event.

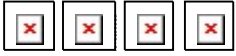
