Good Afternoon John,

In reference to the second sentence in the below email. This department would require documentation from the manufacturer of the wash machine that would allow the modification to the length of the cord. Most manufacturers would require the purchase of the exact replacement part to maintain the listing of the product. NEC 110.3(B) states "listed and labeled equipment shall be installed and used in accordance with any instructions included in the listing or labeling". A Minnesota Licensed Electrical Contractor can also extend the permanent wiring to the wash machine to reach the cord end, or maybe the wash machine can be moved to reach the receptacle. Hopefully this was helpful.
