Unit 1 Bathroom SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-The faucet in the tub will not shut off and there is no hot water. Repair or replace the faucet and provide hot water to the tub, this work will require a licensed plumber and may require permits.
