A re-inspection was made on your building on July 23, 2015, in response to a complaint. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected prior to re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on August 20, 2015 at 9:30 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - Front - SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) - Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Repair the railing for the porch, it has rotting wood and broken boards and needs to be secured.
2. Unit 1 - Bathroom - SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 - Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-The faucet in the tub will not shut off and there is no hot water. Repair or replace the faucet and provide hot water to the tub, this work will require a licensed plumber and may require permits.
