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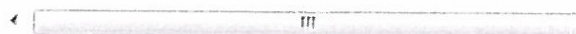

Location: Event will be located outdoors at CHS Stadium

Noise Source: Twin Cities Jazz Festival has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide music outdoors at CHS Stadium on Thursday, June 25, 2015, Friday, June 26, 2015, and Saturday June 27, 2015, from 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on June 25, 26, and 27, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 100 dBA as measured 100 feet from sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the dates of the event.
