## Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on March 17, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on April 22, 2010 at 1:30 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Awning windows - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work requires permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-

### All 4 bedrooms – first floor

Open 22 inches out and 45.5 inches wide Glazed 6.5 sq ft Sill heights are 56 inches from the floor. Window crank handles are more than 5 feet from the floor.

- 2. All sleeping rooms MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 3. Basement MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 4. Basement MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 5. Front door MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction.

  Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Excessive effort required to open front door.

  Provide an approved door that is easily openable.
- 6. Throughout MSFC 901.6 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service.-Remove or replace extinguishers that have not been serviced within the last year.
- 7. MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-Remove illegal latch key locks from bedroom doors.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 10. MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
