A re-inspection will be made on or after August 1, 2011. All work must be inspected and approved under permit prior to this date. Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

3. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the door in good condition.
