A making finding resolution will go before a Legislative Hearing scheduled for October 13, 2020 at 10 a.m. at which owners, interested parties and Department of Safety and Inspection staff will present information on the current building conditions and progress toward abatement of the dangerous/nuisance conditions and the resulting findings will be presented to the City Council at a public hearing on October 28. New letter will be sent before that time.
