This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that a variance be issued to allow construction activity associated with the Central Corridor Light Rail and Skyway project at the Bremer Bank site between 4th & 5th Streets, and East Cedar and Minnesota Street, between 10:00 p.m. and 1:30 a.m., Monday through Saturday from September 1, 2011 to November 1, 2011.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **August 17, 2011, 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.
