Your building was inspected on January 7, 2013 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on February 12, 2013 at 3:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. <u>Exterior Throughout Property SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2)</u> Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. (HN-1)

- <u>Interior Basement MSFC 605.1</u> -Provide a grounding jumper around the water meter.
- 4. <u>Interior Unit B MSFC 401.3</u> Immediately report all fire, smoke, unauthorized discharge, release of flammable and/or combustible liquids, or hazardous materials to Fire Department. (9-1-1)
- 5. <u>SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3)</u> Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 6. <u>SPLC 39.02(c)</u> Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
