## Determination of Eligibility

### Reasonings and Findings

Under Minnesota Statute section 268.085, an applicant is not eligible for unemployment benefits between school years or terms, based on work performed for an educational institution. This limitation applies only if the applicant is reasonably assured of approximately equivalent employment with an educational institution in the next school year or term, or with an employer that contracts the applicant's services to an elementary, middle, or high school. "Approximately equivalent employment" means that the terms and conditions of employment in the new school year or term are not substantially less favorable than those the applicant had in the prior school year or term. The applicant does not have reasonable assurance of employment in the next academic year or term with an educational institution or any employer who contracts the applicant's services to elementary or secondary schools.

### Effect of this Determination

Wages the applicant earned with the employer may be used for the payment of unemployment benefits during the period between academic years or terms.
