Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

Bathroom Lisa Unit SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private hand sink. This work may require a permit(s). Call LIEP at (651) 266-9090. Bathroom sink runs continuously repair
- 2. Bathroom wall Lisa unit SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated wall coverings.
- 3. Kitchen Lisa Unit SPLC 34.10 (7) Repair and maintain the cabinets in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the damaged or missing door.
- 4. Lisa Unit MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-Hard wired smoke detectors must be replace with

hard wired smoke detectors, you cannot substitute battery operated for hard wired smoke detectors

- 5. Lisa Unit SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code.-Repair or replace the oven
- 6. Living room and kitchen LIsa Unit SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17(5) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the floor coverings. Repair or replace the floor tile.
- 7. Mice LIsa Unit SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.34 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-
- 8. Throughout apartment LIsa Unit MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-
