Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on December 9, 2010. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on January 4, 2011 at 12NOON.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.
- 2. Front Steps SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 3. Front Steps SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 4. House SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
- 5. Main floor MSFC 605.1 Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

- 6. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 7. SPLC 34.11 (5), 34.34 (2) Contact a licensed contractor to repair or replace the water heater. This work WILL require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Installations without a permit.
- 8. SPLC 34.08 (10) Repair, replace and maintain exterior sidewalks, walkways and stairs.
- 9. SPLC SEC 198.02 Wild or exotic animals- Means any mammal reptile which is of a species not usually domesticated and of a species which due to size wild nature or other characteristic is dangerous to humans.
