Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **May 09, 2019** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

1. **SPLC 34.08 GARBAGE STORAGE:** Garbage containers cannot be stored on the boulevard/public sidewalk/street except on the day of collection. Immediately cease storage of containers on the boulevard/public sidewalk/street. **FOUND TRASH AND RECYCLING CONTAINERS ON THE BOULEVARD. PLEASE REMOVE AND STORE THE CONTAINERS BY THE HOUSE ON NON-PICK-UP DAYS.**

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on **May 17, 2019**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. **Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges²** and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)

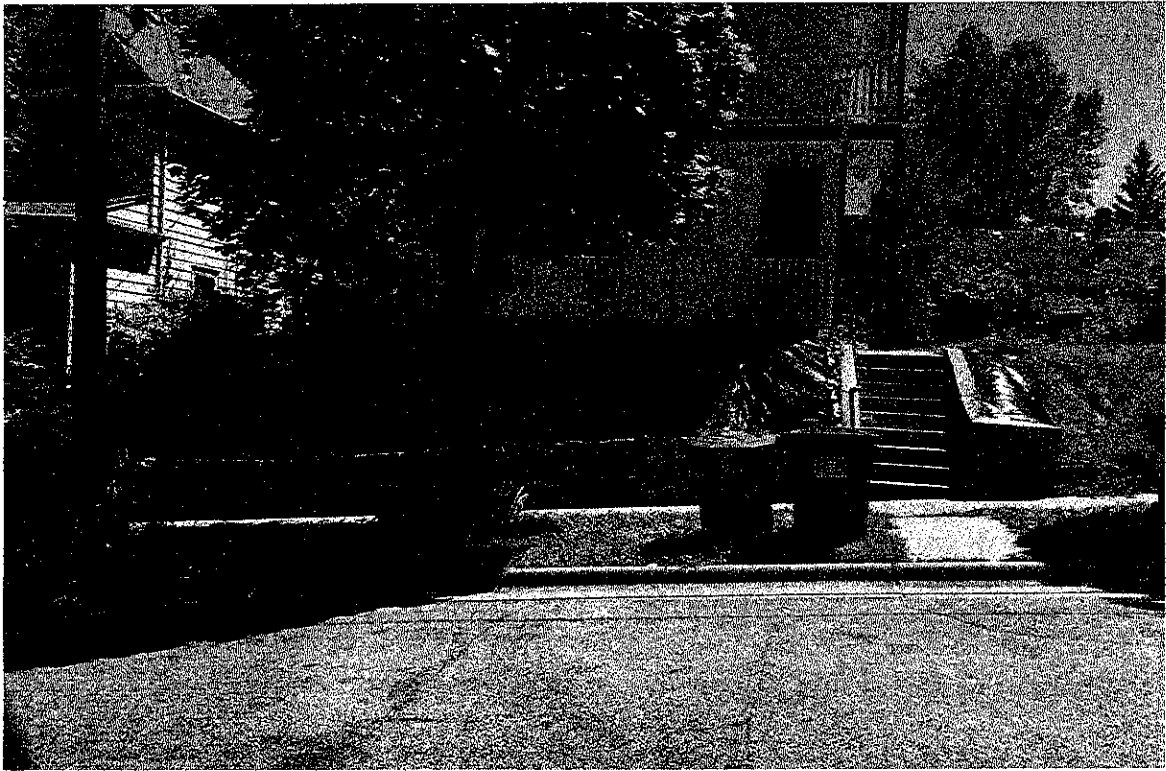

- ² Criminal charges can be brought on the day the violation is observed, but generally we allow time to correct unless this is a repeat violation.

The Enforcement officer cited 24 Congress st. West for garbage and recycling containers on the boulevard. For as long as we have owned the property we have had problems with the trash containers. The property is on a very steep hill. We went though a bunch of trash containers because of the height of the front stairs. As the full trash bins were brought down the stairs it would break the wheels off of the bin. Up until now the tenants had football players to move the trash up and down from the boulevard to the yard. They are going off to college. Somebody is going to be injured moving all these containers up the stairs or down the stairs. We do not have an alley; we only have the front to put the trash out.
