- 8. Unit #2 MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-Install thumb throw latch dead bolt lock
- 9. Units #1 and #2 SPLC 34.10 (5), 34.33 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.-Have a professional carpet cleaning service clean and sanitize the carpets do to dog urine stains provide receipt to the inspector
- 10. Yard area SPLC 45.03 (6) Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall.
- 11. Yard area SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
- 12. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 13. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 14. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 15. MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.


