### Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative: Your vacate date has been extended to November 21,2012

Your building was inspected on October 17, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on or after November 21, 2012 or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. 2nd Floor SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.After securing toilet to floorcaulk the base.
- 2. 2nd Floor MSFC 315.2.5 Fueled equipment, including but not limited to motorcycles, mopeds, lawn-care equipment and portable cooking equipment, shall not be stored, operator or repaired within a building. Remove charcoal grill from the closet piano room
- 3. 2nd Floor SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902. A SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition. Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure the toilet to the floor.
- 4. 2nd Floor Patio storm-door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition This door is broken and is in need of repair.

- 5. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 6. MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-Various locations. There is a multiplug adapter in the kitchen. There are power strips piggy backed in the upstairs bedroom on the south west side and the Piano room on the north east side. Upstairs.
- 7. NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptable shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-Various locations. Piano room upstairs and in the living room downstairs and the kitchen.
