A re-inspection will be made on August 16, 2016 at 2:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-Repair cracks in driveway.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.

- 3. Interior Basement NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.
- 4. Interior Basement MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Have an HVAC contractor pull a permit and replace dryer vent.
- 5. Interior Basement Bedroom SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-Repair leak.
- 6. Interior MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 7. Interior SPLC 34.13 (2), (3), SPLC 34.17 (2) Reduce and maintain the number of occupants in the unit to:-4 unrelated adults.
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
