### **CORRECTION NOTICE**

RE: 642 HALL AVE

Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **May 20, 2014** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code<sup>1</sup> (see footnote 1, below).

1. The retaining wall between 642 Hall Ave and 15 Baker St W, has failed and has collapsed. This wall must be repaired or replaced. Retaining walls supporting more than 4 feet of earth behind them require a permit. This retaining wall has been a contentious issue between the two properties referenced. It is suggested that the property owners work out an amicable solution to repairing or replacing the wall. Failing that alternative, it is suggested the affected properties file an appeal (instructions are below).

(An identical letter has been sent to both property owners.)

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after **June 02, 2014**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. **Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges**<sup>2</sup> and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)

If you have any questions or request additional information, please contact me. To arrange an appointment or request an extension of time to complete repairs, you will need to speak directly to me at 651-266-1914.

Any such future costs will be collected by assessment against the real property and are in addition to any other fines or assessments which may be levied against you and your property.

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
