Dear Mr. Rowe:

The investigation into your claim has been completed.

The Department of Labor & Industry's State Board of Appeal's remanded your case back to the City of Saint Paul's Fire Official for handling under the last paragraph of their decision dated December 19th, 2018. As such, it would be up to a City of Saint Paul employee to render a decision on your case. Per the Department of Safety & Inspections (DSI), there are no pending issues on your case so there is nothing further to be decided by the City's Fire Official for the 2018 matter.

Further, any actions taken by any City of Saint Paul employee are protected from any claims under Minnesota Statute 466.05, subdivision 5, Execution of Statute. This means that any claim based upon an act or omission of an officer or employee, exercising due care, in the execution of a valid or invalid statute, charter, ordinance, resolution or rule.

As such, your claim for damages against the employees of the Department of Safety & Inspection and the City of Saint Paul for improper action are prohibited under Minnesota Statute. Therefore, your claim is respectfully denied.
