FIRE INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 19, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on February 23, 2011 at 1:30pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - Dryer Vent - UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Remove the unapproved flexible metal exhaust duct on the gas dryer and replace with the approved type. Flexible metal duct is acceptable for approved transitions only. This work must be done by licensed contractor under permit.

- 2. Basement Fire Extinguisher MSFC 901.6 Have fire extinguisher recharged and tagged.-Fire extinguishers are not required in a single family residence. If fire extinguishers are present they are required to be serviced annually by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service. Provide the required annual maintenance of the existing fire extinguishers dated 2005.
- 3. Basement Laundry Room SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door latch.-Replace the missing door handles on the doors leading into the laundry room.
- 4. Basement Storage Room MSFC 605.1 Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Remove the incorrectly installed light fixture and unapproved exposed electrical wiring in the storage room to the left of the basement stairway. All electrical wiring must be done by licensed contractor under permit according to the electrical code.
- 5. Egress Windows Main Floor Bedrooms MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Main Floor Southwest Bedroom (Double-hung)

23h x 23w - Openable

48h x 21w - Glazed

Main Floor Southeast Bedroom (Double-hung)

23h x 34w - Openable

48h x 33w - Glazed

Main Floor Northwest Bedroom (Double-hung)

Unable to open either window for measurement because they were frozen shut.

- 6. Main Floor Bedrooms MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 7. Main Floor Kitchen NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-Remove and discontinue the use of the extension cord used to supply power to the gas range. Ranges must be plugged directly into a permanent outlet.
- 8. Main Floor Kitchen MFGC 409.5 Provide an approved gas shut off valve within 6 feet of the appliance in accordance with the mechanical code. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Provide the required gas shut-off valve for the gas range.

- 9. Main Floor Living Room SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-Repair/replace the window that is not staying in the open position.
- 10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 11. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.


