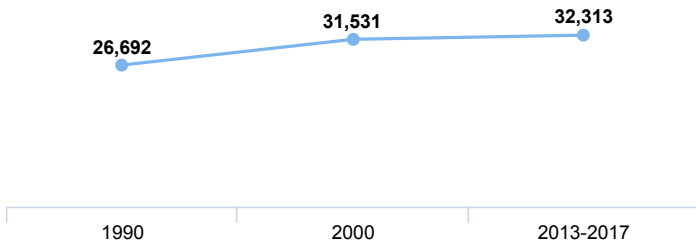

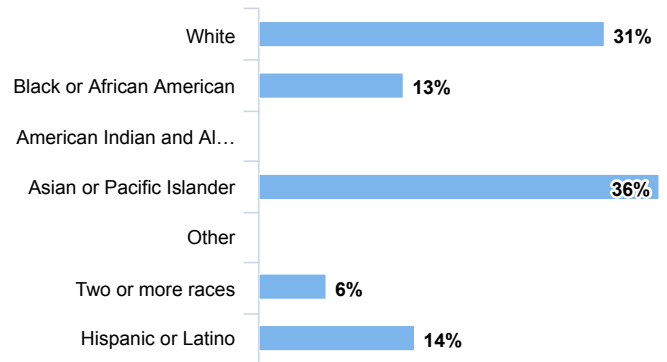

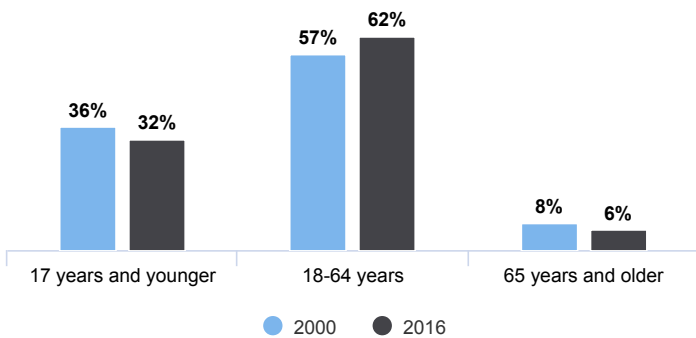
Total population



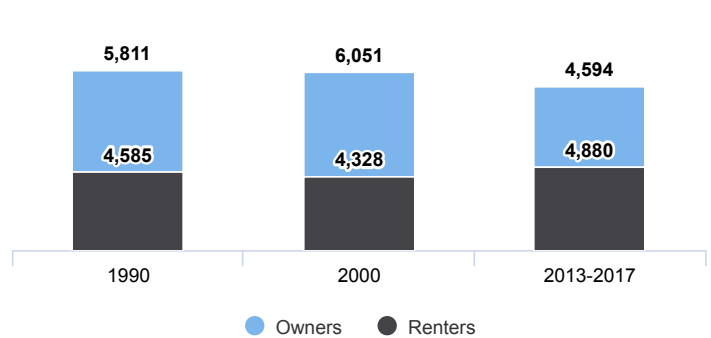
Population by race/ethnicity, 2017



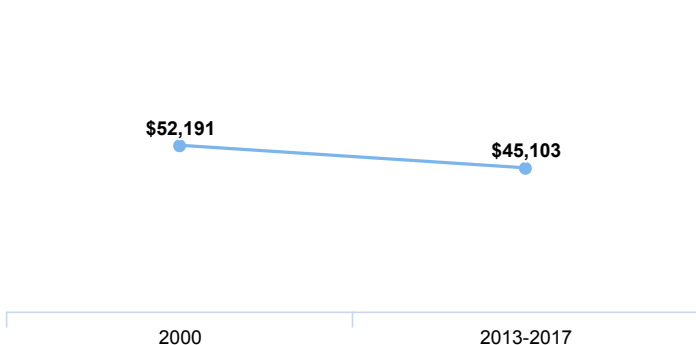
Population by age



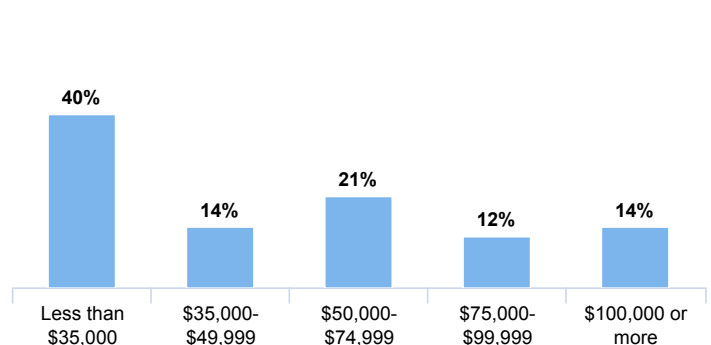
Households by tenure

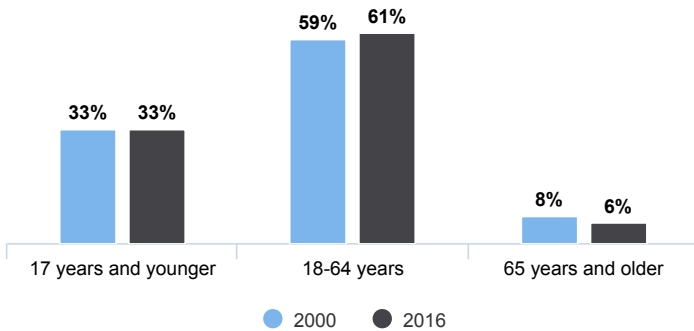

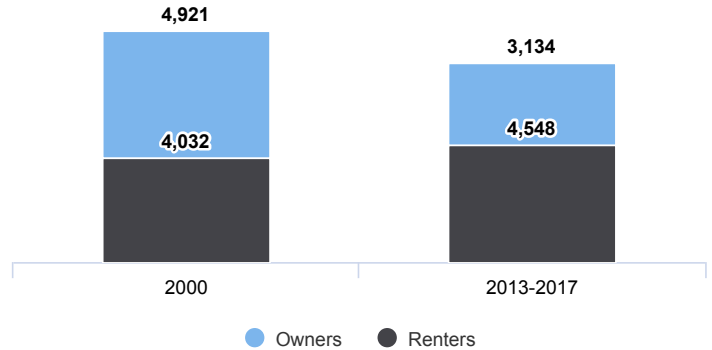
Population by race/ethnicity, 2017



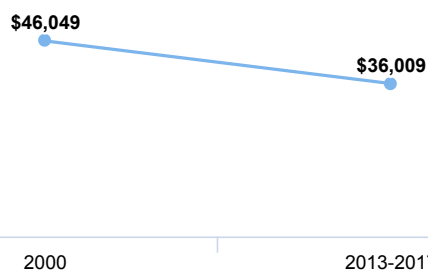
Population by age



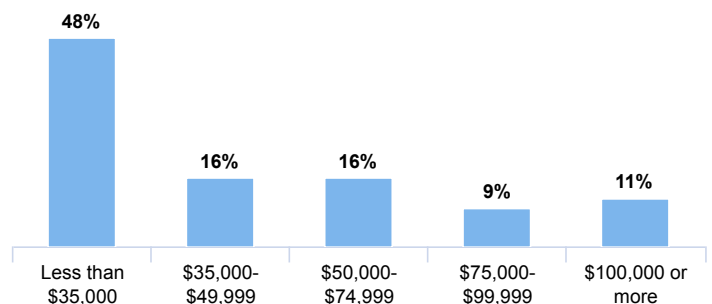
Households by tenure

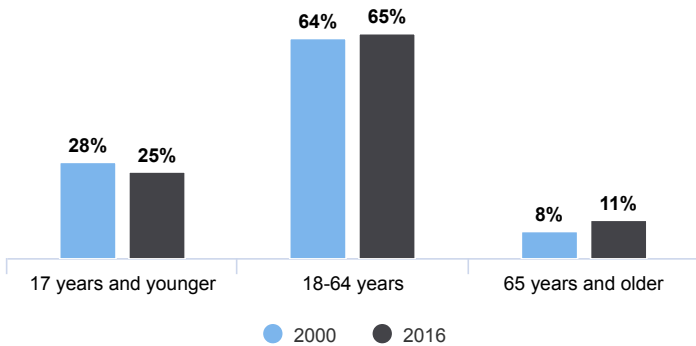

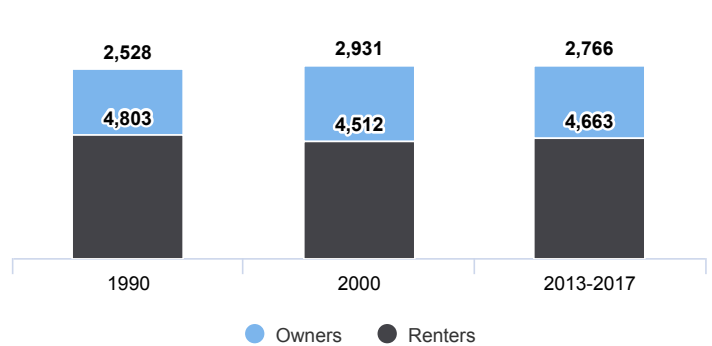
Population by race/ethnicity, 2017



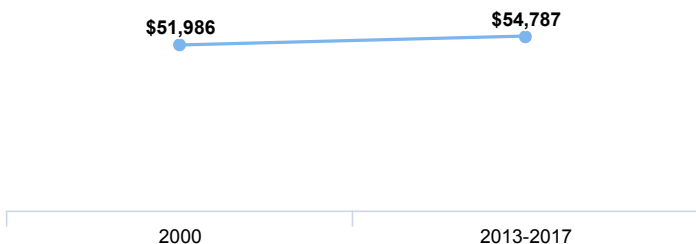
Population by age



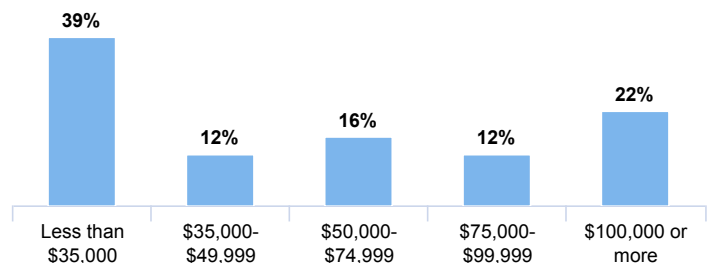
