Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on December 10, 2010. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on January 12, 2011 at 1:30pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Laundry Room NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-Remove the extension cord used to supply power to the washer and/or dryer. Washers and dryers must be plugged directly into a permanent outlet. **Obtain electrical permit for the newly installed electrical outlet near the washer/dryer.**Contact electrical inspector for final inspection.
- 2. Basement Laundry Room UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work will require a permit. Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Obtain permit for the newly installed dryer vent. Contact mechanical/warm air inspector for final inspection.

- 3. Garage Fire Door MSFC 703 The fire door must not be obstructed or impaired from its proper operation at any time.-Provide an automatic door closer on the door between the tuck-under garage and the dwelling unit. The fire door is not closing and latching. Provide strike plate for the door.
- 4. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
