Hangman Productions USA Inc. has applied for a Sound Level Variance for Red Bull Crashed Ice, an international ice cross downhill event, to be held in an area near the Saint Paul Cathedral that includes North Cathedral Hill Park, Monument Park, Cathedral Hill Park, South Cathedral Hill Park and Arch Park. The event will be held Wednesday, February 19, 2014 through Saturday, February 22, 2014. To allow for track preparation, setup, takedown and ice maintenance, the variance is being requested to start on Monday, January 27, 2014 and run through Monday, March 3, 2014 for the track ice chillers and generators that will be operating 24 hours a day during this time period. Chillers and generators will not exceed 80 decibels at 15 feet. Loudspeakers will only be used on February 19, 2014 through February 22, 2014, between 4:00 PM and 10:00 PM and not exceed 95 decibels at 80 feet. The anticipated City Council Public Hearing date is scheduled for January 15, 2014, in the City Council Chambers at 5:30 p.m.
