Description of Variance

Location: Event will be located outdoors at Mears Park

Noise Source: Brian Horst, Event Director has applied for a sound level variance, at a requested sound level of 90 dBA at 50 feet in order to provide music outdoors at Mears Park on twelve (12) Thursdays, June 9, 2016 through August 25, 2016. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for amplified music for the hours from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on twelve (12) Thursdays starting June 9, 2016 through August 25, 2016. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 90 dBA, as measured at 50 feet from the noise source from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who will provide sound level monitoring to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 9:00 p.m. on each event date.
