Dear Mr. Grams:

This is to confirm that our office has received your Michels Corporation for a City Sewer Lining Work Project on Jackson Street application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended that a variance be issued, with conditions. DSI's recommendations are to allow for a 30 hour continuous construction project for City of Saint Paul Sewer Lining Work on Jackson Street from the intersection of 5th Street South to Kellogg Boulevard, starting at 7:00 a.m. on April 11, 2016 for 30 hours continuously into April 12, 2016. The variance includes night time work, with sound levels from 10:00 p.m. on April 11, 2016 through 7:00 a.m. on April 12, 2016 to be at 70 dBA at 50 feet from the sound source. DSI is recommending that the occupants of property located within 400 feet of the work location be notified in writing by Michels Corporation, a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours prior to the start of the work.

The public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **Wednesday, March 16, 2016 at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W, Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
