Your building was inspected on February 4, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. <u>A re-inspection will be made on March 4, 2011 at 1:30p.m.</u>

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Second floor - SPLC 34.13 (1) - Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.-Second floor has an occupy able floor area at 5 feet up to 6 feet 5 inches of 196 sqft. The area at 6 feet 5 inches is 2 feet wide by 28 feet long which equals 56 sqft of the occupy able floor area. this area is only about 1/3 of the floor area. The area under 5 feet has storage areas built in or other storage and was not used to measure the floor area.

- 2. South East MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-The south east bedroom egress window is double hung and has an openable height of 21 inches with the stops in place and 22 inches with the stops removed with an oppenable with of 25 inches and a glazed area of 8.6 sqft.
- 3. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 4. Remove the accumulation of snow or ice from the public and private sidewalk abutting this property.
