Location: Shepard Road at Washington Street and at Sherman Street for the Event Start and Finish

Noise Source: Podium Sports Marketing has applied for a sound level variance, at a 85 decibel (dBA) requested sound level limit at no specified distance, in order to present amplified music and announcements on Shepard Road at Washington Street and at Sherman Street for the Event Start and Finish. The Turkey Trot Saint Paul is to be held on Thursday, November 23, 2017, from 7:15 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections recommends the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 7:15 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. for the event on Thursday, November 23, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 a.m. on the date of the event.
