## Sound Level Variance Application

City of Saint Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293)

**Note:** A public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council is required. Application and fee must be received no fewer than forty five (45) days prior to the public hearing date that is before the requested Variance start date.

Michels Corp. for City sewer lining work.

1. Organization/person seeking variance: Sewer lining work will occur on Jackson St. from 5th to Kellogg.
2. Mailing Address w/zip code: Public Works, Sewer Utility, 25 W. 4th St, 700 CHA.

4. Event Name: City Sewer lining. Work will be on the west side Jackson St. from the intersection 5th St. to Kellogg Blvd.

6. Date(s) during which the variance is requested: Continuous from Monday, April 11 through Tuesday, April 12.
7. Noise source - Time(s) of operation: The installation of the sewer liner on Jackson St. will require 30-hrs of continuous work.  
- Time(s) of pre-event sound check: No sound check.
8. Address or legal description of Noise source: Sewer lining work on the west side Jackson St. from the intersection 5th St. to Kellogg Blvd.
9. Sound level requested: Night work. 70 DBA at a distance of 50 feet from 10:00PM April 11 through 7:00AM April 12.
10. Describe the noise source and all equipment involved: During daytime hours of 7am - 10:00PM, equipment, and vehicles with back up alarms, power tools will be used. During nighttime hours of 10:00PM - 7:00AM, equipment with noise attenuation will be used.  
Noise will be restricted to 70 DBA at a distance of 50 feet.
11. Describe the steps that will be taken to minimize the noise levels: Use of equipment and power tools will be limited to daytime hours. During nighttime hours, equipment with noise attenuation will be used.  
Noise will be restricted to 70 DBA at a distance of 50 feet.
12. State reason for seeking variance: The sewer on Jackson St between 5th and Kellogg must be repaired. The project will take one week to complete. When the sewer liner is installed, work must continue uninterrupted for 30-hrs.

13. Attach site diagram showing location of noise source(s), streets, stages, tents, etc. (If there will be amplified sound, indicate location and direction that all speakers will be facing.) Multiple locations may require more than one application.
